Player Cross Registration Policy.

The Club have introduced the following policy regarding players who wish to register for more than one team within the Club.

1. All players must first register with one team only as their "Primary Team" and will pay their annual Club subscriptions to that Team Manager.
2. Any Manager seeking to register a player already registered with another Droitwich Spa team may only do so if they have the minimum recommended number of players already registered. This is 12 players for 9-a-side teams and 14 players for 11-a-side teams.
3. Any player registered to two teams must train at least 3 times a month with their Primary Team.
4. Any player who plays for their alternative squad must pay £2.50 per match to the manager of that squad.
5. It is the intention that players registered for two teams will only be called upon to play for their alternative team when that team has a shortfall of players (below the recommended minimum number above) for any particular match due to illness, injury or other commitments of players in that team.
6. All "dual registrations" will require prior approval of the Club Committee.
7. The Club Committee reserve the right to withdraw permission for any "dual registration" if it believes a player or team is being unfairly affected.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all players in the Club are treated fairly in terms of their opportunity to play football and receive equal value for money from their annual subscriptions. It is also necessary to control "over playing" of young players and to ensure this remains within FA guidelines.
